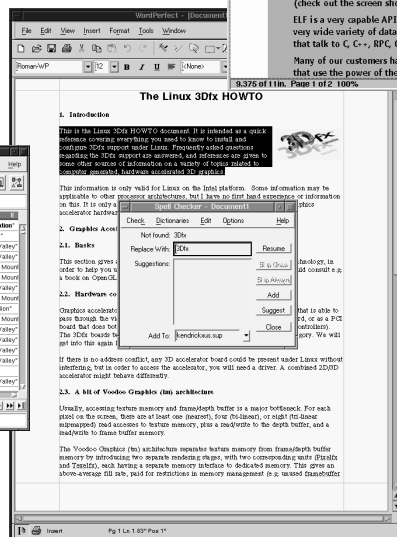
Where do you want to go tomorrow?

Using the X Window program, you can tailor your desktop to fit your individual needs. Linux provides a stable and secure alternative to the Windows family of operating systems.

There is a wide variety of office applications for Linux, many that rival if not exceed those available for Microsoft Windows and many are completely free.

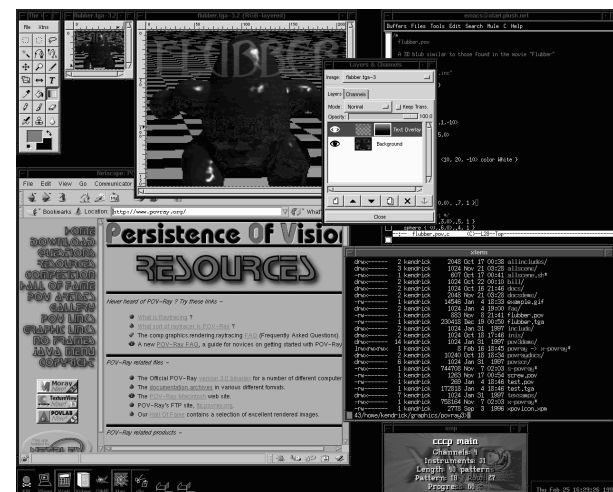
StarOffice

StarOffice, a suite of productivity applications comparable to Microsoft Office, has proved that Linux users do not have to sacrifice any features in a modern office suite. It has a fully integrated set of powerful applications which provide word processing, spreadsheet, graphic design, presentation, database access, HTML editing, mail/news reading, event planning, and formula editing. StarOffice runs native on all major operating environments including Linux, Windows NT/95/98, Macintosh, and OS/2. StarOffice is fully compatible with Microsoft Office file formats, allowing users can access existing Microsoft Office files and data and save their documents in forms readable by Microsoft Office users. StarOffice Personal edition is available free for download from www.stardivision.com.



WordPerfect

WordPerfect is the original word processing standard in the office environment. Now available for Linux, it delivers the same word-processing capabilities as the Windows version of WordPerfect, plus many features available only for Linux, including the ability to share information easily with enhanced compatibility features and support for over 1,000 printers. WordPerfect for Linux can be downloaded free from linux.corel.com. WordPerfect is also available for other platforms, including Windows NT/95/98, Macintosh, DOS, and UNIX.



The GIMP

The GIMP, an acronym for GNU Image Manipulation Program, is the Linux alternative to Adobe Photoshop. It is an extremely powerful piece of software with many capabilities. It can be used as a simple paint program, an expert quality photo retouching program, an online batch processing system, a mass production image renderer, an image format converter, as well as many other uses. Like Photoshop, it is designed to be augmented with plugins and extensions to do just about anything. The advanced scripting interface allows everything from the simplest task to the most complex image manipulation procedures to be easily scripted. GIMP can be downloaded free from <http://www.gimp.org>. Versions are also available for the Windows platform and OS/2.
